4 Should the Charter specifically address the issue of tax collection? If so, how?	
5 Should the Charter include a detailed Code of Ethics and/or Conflict of Interest provisions or should the Charter mandate that the Administrative Code provide for such (with specific essential elements and within certain parameters defined in the Charter)?	
6 Should the Charter include a detailed personnel system for the township or should the Charter mandate that the Administrative Code provide for such (with specific essential elements and within certain parameters defined in the Charter)?	
7 Should the Charter include a detailed competitive bidding process for purchases of over a certain amount or should the Charter mandate that the Administrative Code provide for such (with specific essential elements and within certain parameters defined in the Charter)?	
8 Should the Charter outline the various administrative departments as an interim structure until the Administrative Code is adopted?
