RESOLUTION NO. 49 - 2017 RESOLUTION FOR PLAN REVISION

RESOLUTION OF THE CONCORD TOWNSHIP COUNCIL, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the municipality").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted there under, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the **Pennsylvania Code**, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Bradford Engineering Associates, Inc. has prepared a Component 3M Minor Act 537 Plan Revision. The name of the project is the Colonial Village Sewer Extension Project and will provide public sewers to a section of the Township in need.

Colonial Village consists of 83 existing residential single-family homes. **The Alternative of Choice for this section of the project is the installation of a new low-pressure sewer system.** All homes will connect to the new public sewer via individual grinder pumps.

The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
