## **ARMED BANK ROBBERY**

**Concord Township, Delaware County** – The Pennsylvania State Police, Troop K, Media Station is investigating an armed bank robbery. The robbery occurred on Tuesday, December 19, 2017, at approximately 12:00 PM at the Malvern Federal Savings Bank, 900 block of Baltimore Pike, Concord Township, Delaware County. The suspect is described as a black male with light to medium complexion, approx. 20-35 years of age. He was last seen wearing a black face mask, blue jeans, and a white fishing hat. The suspect displayed a black handgun with silver barrel and an imitation explosive device. The suspect stole a large amount of US Currency and fled the scene in a silver Pontiac G6 sedan. The suspect vehicle is reported stolen out of New Castle County, Delaware. Anyone that encounters this suspect and or vehicle should use extreme caution.
