PA State Police – Public Information Release Report

Regarding Theft from Motor Vehicles & Theft of Motor Vehicles

Over the past several months, PSP Media has received numerous reports of thefts from and thefts of motor vehicles in the area. Many of these have occurred in Edgemont and Middletown Townships, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, during the overnight hours. In these instances, vehicles that are left unlocked are accessed by unknown actor(s) and rummaged through taking anything of value to include electronic devices, U.S. Currency and firearms. On several occasions there have been instances where a vehicle is left unlocked and the key for the vehicle is present. In these instances the vehicles have been stolen. Residents are asked to never leave the keys to your vehicle inside your car and also to secure your vehicle when left unattended. We are also urging residents to secure their firearms inside of their residences and not in their vehicles.
