Dear Customer,

In 2018 Township Council approved new sewer rates to provide a more equitable rate structure for their customers. As a result of that rate change for consumption, the Township has been asked to consider sewer rate credits for customers using irrigation systems and/or for the filling of pools. The Township has considered and evaluated these requests, and the Township has decided to not offer sewer credits for outside uses as they are deemed to be discretionary on the part of the homeowner. However, please note that both Chester Water Authority (CWA) and Suez Water will at the homeowners request/cost install separate metering systems for these types of uses. In addition, we encourage all of our sewer customers to check out the Township's website at www.townshipofconcord.com for tips for water conservation, tips for installing rain barrels to offset landscaping watering needs, contact information for companies that offer pool fill services, and important contact information for CWA and Suez to obtain more information on separate metering. We hope that all of our customers understand the importance of water conservation and the Township's role in protecting its sewer system and our natural resources.
