

USE OF FACILITIES REGULATIONS

1. The Township Parks are for the enjoyment of all Concord Township residents and will remain open to the public during your event. Three (3) hour maximum rental time for pavilion.
2. Applicants must fully comply with the requirements of the Township ordinances, state and federal laws.
3. Applications for use of Township parks or property shall be considered on a first come basis, the date of application filing being the date received by the Township.
4. Use of Parks or Township property is primarily for Township residents or groups organized in Concord Township.
5. In the event of a conflict in the date of requested use of the Park or Township property, preference shall be given to groups or Township organizations which serve the welfare of the entire community or are of a public nature. Preference shall be given to historical and charitable organizations of a non-profit nature being located in Concord Township.
6. Applicants shall make proper arrangements to clean all paper and other debris from the Park.
7. No special permit shall be issued in the event the performance, exhibition, play, show or party is of an inappropriate nature.
8. No special permit shall be issued for the use of the Park or Township property in the event that it is not feasible due to the condition of the property, lack of parking facilities, possibility of excessive noise levels or any use which is contrary to the public health, safety and welfare of the community or use which would excessively damage the Park or Township property. Applicants shall agree to abide by any special conditions or special requirements issued by Concord Township.
9. Concord Township shall refuse to issue a special permit in the event applicant is not in compliance with Township Ordinances, state and federal laws or these rules and regulations. A permit shall be issued or the application denied in writing not more than fifteen (15) days after receiving the applications.
10. In the event an application for a special permit is denied or not issued, the applicant may appeal to the Council Members within thirty (30) days of denial or failure to issue the permit.
11. Concord Township shall deny the issuance of a special permit to any applicant or organization which discriminates against any person due to race, religion, sex, age, national origin, or disability.
12. **NO open fires, or grills of any kind are allowed.**
13. **NO alcoholic beverages or glass bottles are allowed.**
14. **NO group parties over fifty (50) persons.**
15. **NO tents are permitted.**
16. **Cancellation Policy:** If you don't cancel within 48 hours a \$50.00 deposit will be kept for cancellation fee. A seventy-two (72) hour notice prior to the event, the full amount will be refunded
